Thank you all for another year of support, through finances, prayer and encouragement. We plod along doing a variety of ministries, which I am sure will have an eternal impact for everyone involved.

Local Ministry

Ministry with the Aborigines has continued steadily, with the annual retreat in Busselton and a number of Bible studies in Bunbury. Please pray for encouragement and endurance the ladies -- they continually struggle with children and now grandchildren who are wasting their lives in drugs and alcohol, enslaved in a cycle of domestic violence and jail.

Thanks again to Angela for her faithfulness in sewing our bags. Our supply of material to make the bags is nearly finished.

Our Sunday home group continues along. Numbers hover around 6-8, but it is a great time of fellowship and time in the Word of God.

During the year, we have given about 12,000 Living Waters (Gospel of John) to our friends, who are actively evangelizing on the streets and from house to house.

Mission Trips

Beth and I have had several trips overseas. In the early days, our trips were mainly ministry, with a few days of relaxation. These days, we are enjoying much more relaxation, especially when we are able to bring our friends from other countries to Thailand for a whole bunch of new experiences and fellowship.

Finances
